## 3 Strikes system

If you do not abide by these expectations is will have consequences. We use the 3 Strikes System:

- 1) Conversation with member of staff, logged.
- 2) Sent home to change by Head of Sixth Form parents informed.
- 3) Out of public circulation for the day working independently near the Sixth Form office. Followed by a conversation with parents.
