Dear Parents and Carers,
School Uniform Policy - Jewellery

I am writing to you today regarding our school uniform policy, specifically concerning the wearing of jewellery. We are incredibly proud of our students, and the vast majority consistently arrive at school looking very smart and wearing their uniform correctly. It is wonderful to see them representing the school with such pride.

Recently, however, we have noticed an increase in the amount of jewellery being worn by some students which is not permitted in school. Tomorrow, we will be speaking with all students to remind them of our expectations regarding jewellery. Following this, starting from Monday, we will be implementing the following:

- As students arrive at school, staff will be reminding anyone wearing jewellery to remove it immediately.
- Once removed, all jewellery is expected to remain off and safely stored away in bags or pockets for the entire duration of the school day.
- If a student is seen wearing jewellery later in the school day after the morning reminders, the item will be confiscated by staff. Any refusal will result in the normal procedures being followed.
- Confiscated items will be securely held and can be collected at the end of the day by the student. For students who repeatedly do not meet the expectations parents will be required to collect the jewellery.

We greatly appreciate your support in discussing these expectations with your child this weekend to ensure they are fully prepared for Monday without the risk of having items confiscated.
