



## EDUCATIONAL VISITS

Unfortunately, the School's travel insurance policy does not cover any claims resulting from pre-existing medical conditions. **Therefore, if your son/daughter is receiving or awaiting treatment for an illness or injury at a hospital or as an out patient, and your son/daughter is travelling abroad with the school we would advise you to take out your own insurance for medical cover.**

**It is a condition of the School's insurance that your son/daughter is not travelling against the advice of their doctor.** Therefore, if your son/daughter is unwell or injured, at the time of booking a place on a school trip, and/or immediately before departure, it is your responsibility to check with his/her doctor that he/she will be fit to travel. In the event of an insurance claim, the insurers reserve the right to contact your doctor to ensure that this has been done.

Should your son/daughter require an anaesthetic, please give your permission for the person in charge of the school trip to give consent on your behalf for an anaesthetic to be administered or for any other urgent medical treatment to be given by ticking the box at the back of the purple admission form.

**Please note that the School cannot be held responsible for any loss incurred by yourselves in the event of the insurers not meeting a claim.**
