

Information for Parents 25.02.22 – School Closure Remote Learning Update

The following information remains the same as for Thursday 24th February.

Due to the continuing power issues and the impact this is having on our ICT systems we are still unfortunately unable to offer live lessons.

Staff for all students will:

- Set teacher pre-recorded lessons and/or recorded lessons by educational providers such as Oak National Academy through Show My Homework to facilitate student learning at home.
- Ensure work for the day is available prior to your child's normal timetabled lesson. Where possible, lessons will be available from 9am.
- Set work following student timetables. Therefore, students will be set work for the six subjects that they would have in a normal school day on a Monday. The time allocated to learning for each subject will broadly be the same as students would have spent on the subject in school, but we recognise that students may find working at home a different experience. Where possible, they should try to follow the same routine as in school.
- In some cases, use of recognised educational provider such as Oak National Academy, Corbett Maths video lessons may be used to enhance learning experience for our students to meet their needs. These will generally only be used to compliment the lesson resources available but will be intended to enhance learning.
- Be contactable via Show My Homework and their school email to provide support and answer any questions students in their class may have in the time of the day when the lesson would normally be delivered.

Students should aim to:

- Check Show My Homework to see the work allocated for the day and complete this following their normal timetable where possible.
- Submit their work via Show My Homework or directly to their teacher via school email accounts. If this is not possible then your child can bring their work into school when we return.
- If in Year 7 – 10, access Bedrock Learning and complete two sessions to support their vocabulary enrichment.
