

Dear Parent/Carer,

Recently, we have had several incidents where parents are contacting their children via mobile phone during the school day. This causes significant disruption to lessons and can create tension between staff and students. The school rule is that mobile phones should be switched off and in a schoolbag out of sight. Student mobile phones should not be seen on the school site. If a mobile phone is confiscated, it is taken to the school office where a parent can collect it.

If there is a genuine emergency and you need to contact your child, please call the school office who will organise for your child to be collected and supported. Furthermore, there have also been incidents where students are contacting home before speaking to a member of staff in school. This again creates problems in school and does not allow for staff to be proactive in their support of students.

Please may I ask that you have a conversation with your child/children to ensure that there is a positive working relationship between the school and home.
